Lesson

- **Groups:** Four students are enrolled in one session. The class is open to any students qualified to join. It will be one- 1 hour session per week.
- **Semi-private:** Two students are enrolled in one session and the class is open to any students qualified to join. It will be one- 1hour session per week.
- **Private lessons:** One on one lesson. This lesson is closed to all other students. The length of private lessons is based on the student's learning and center time available.
- **College course:** **Only Semi-Private or Private lesson is available.**

- **Study hours:** TBA. Our study hours are unlimited based on schedule and will be available for monthly students only.

- Hourly payment must be paid before tutoring.
